◆ Special Education

Definition:

The Health Instructional Paraeducator, working under the direct supervision of the Summer School Teacher or the Summer School Administrator, assists students with toileting support and other hygiene needs, and assist the teacher and principal with the duties in the classroom and at the school.

Duties:

1. Learn students' names.
2. Assist with attendance procedures.
3. Assist with physical set-up of the room.
4. Keep record of textbooks or library books.
5. Assist with distribution of supplies in the classroom.
6. Collect daily assignments - check for completeness.
7. Supports learning intervention—individually or in small groups.
8. Alert teacher to any unusual behavior on the part of students.
9. Provide campus supervision before school and between classes, at lunch time or after school.
10. Prepare assorted instructional materials.
11. Assist with co-curricular activities.
12. Mark and score objective type papers.
13. Help students on special projects.
14. Orient students who have enrolled late or have been absent.
15. Performs other duties as required or as assigned.

Improving Learning...Together

Minimum Requirements:

High school graduate with some work beyond high school preferred. CPR and First Aid Certificates. Must understand and follow oral and written directions. Ability to work cooperatively with others and to assume responsibility to exercise sound judgment; ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with others; depict dependability, industriousness and good physical condition. Ability to type is desirable. Bilingual ability in English and Spanish is desirable.

Specialized Duties:

1. Support the toileting and hygiene needs of special education students, including diapering, as necessary.
2. Implementation and use of basic first aid, CPR and emergency treatment procedures.
3. Use of specialized equipment and apparatus used for students with special needs.
4. Use of techniques and procedures for lifting, moving and positioning severely disabled students.
5. Protection of self and surroundings from potentially assaultive behavior.
