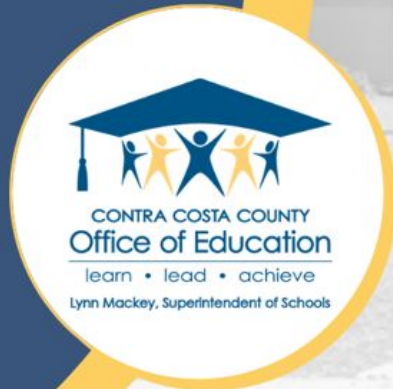

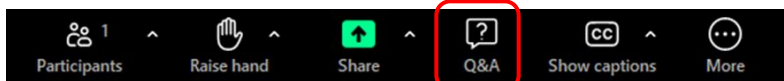
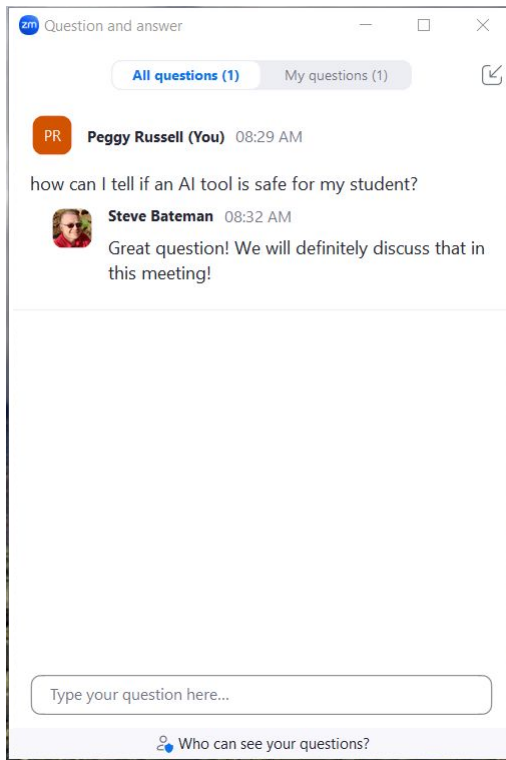




## Accessibility

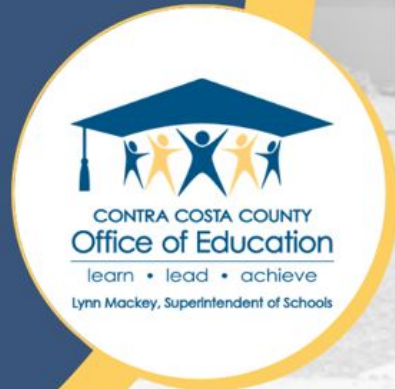

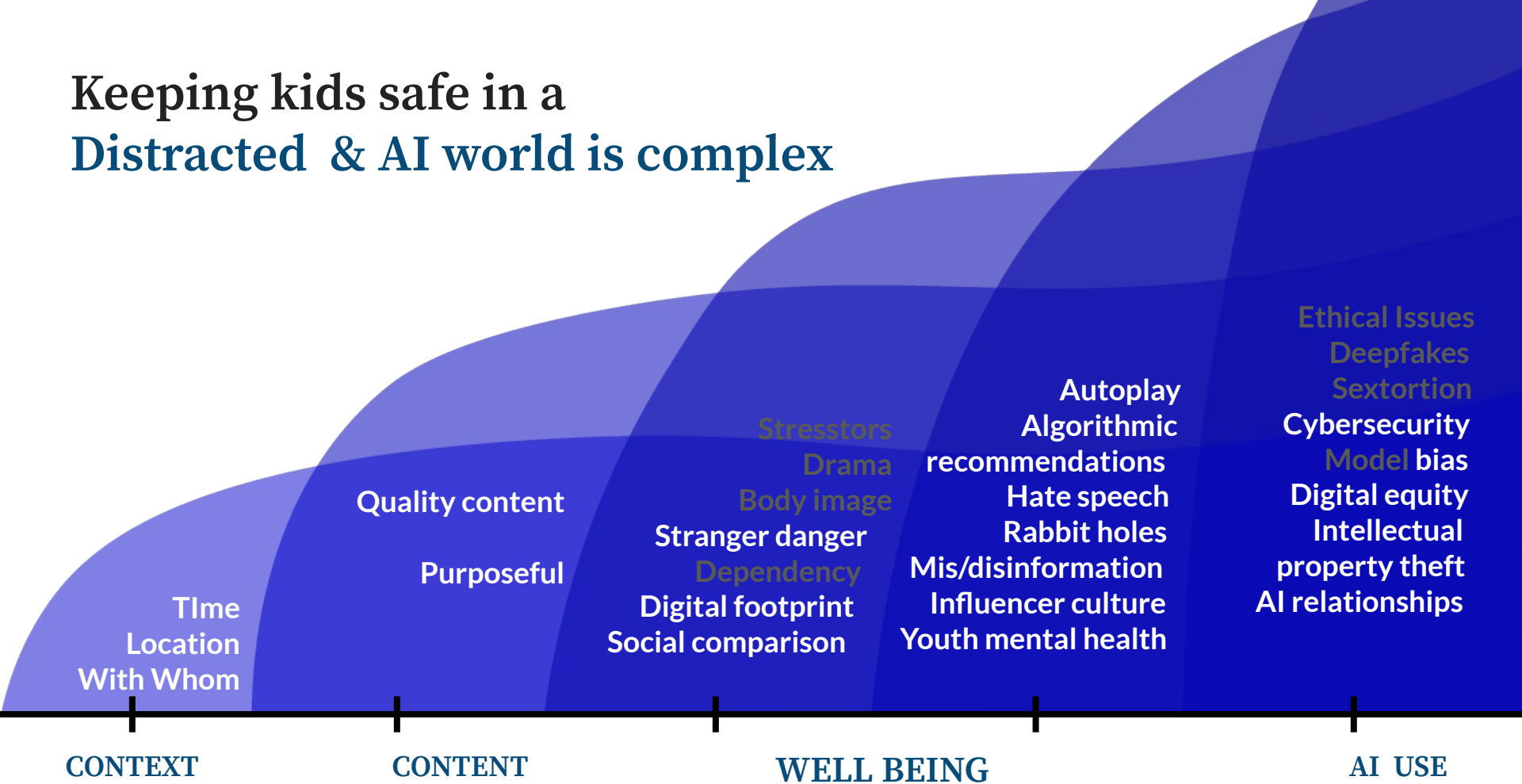

"...your child will be able to use Gemini to ask questions, get homework help and make up stories."

## Some helpful reminders

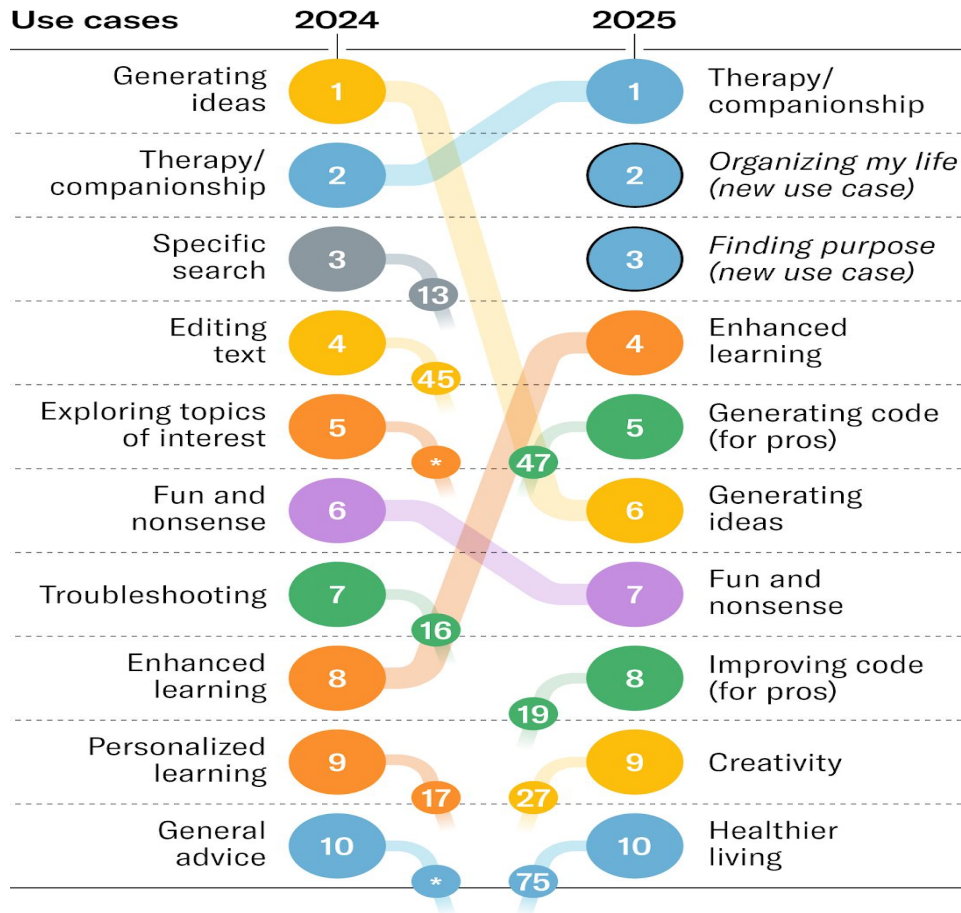
Gemini can make mistakes, so help your child think critically about Gemini responses.

- Remind your child that Gemini isn't human. Even though it sometimes talks like one, it can't think for itself or feel emotions
- Show your child how to **double-check** responses
- Let your child know not to enter sensitive or personal info in Gemini
- Our filters try to limit access to inappropriate content, but they're not perfect.

iPad kids, Tiktok tweens

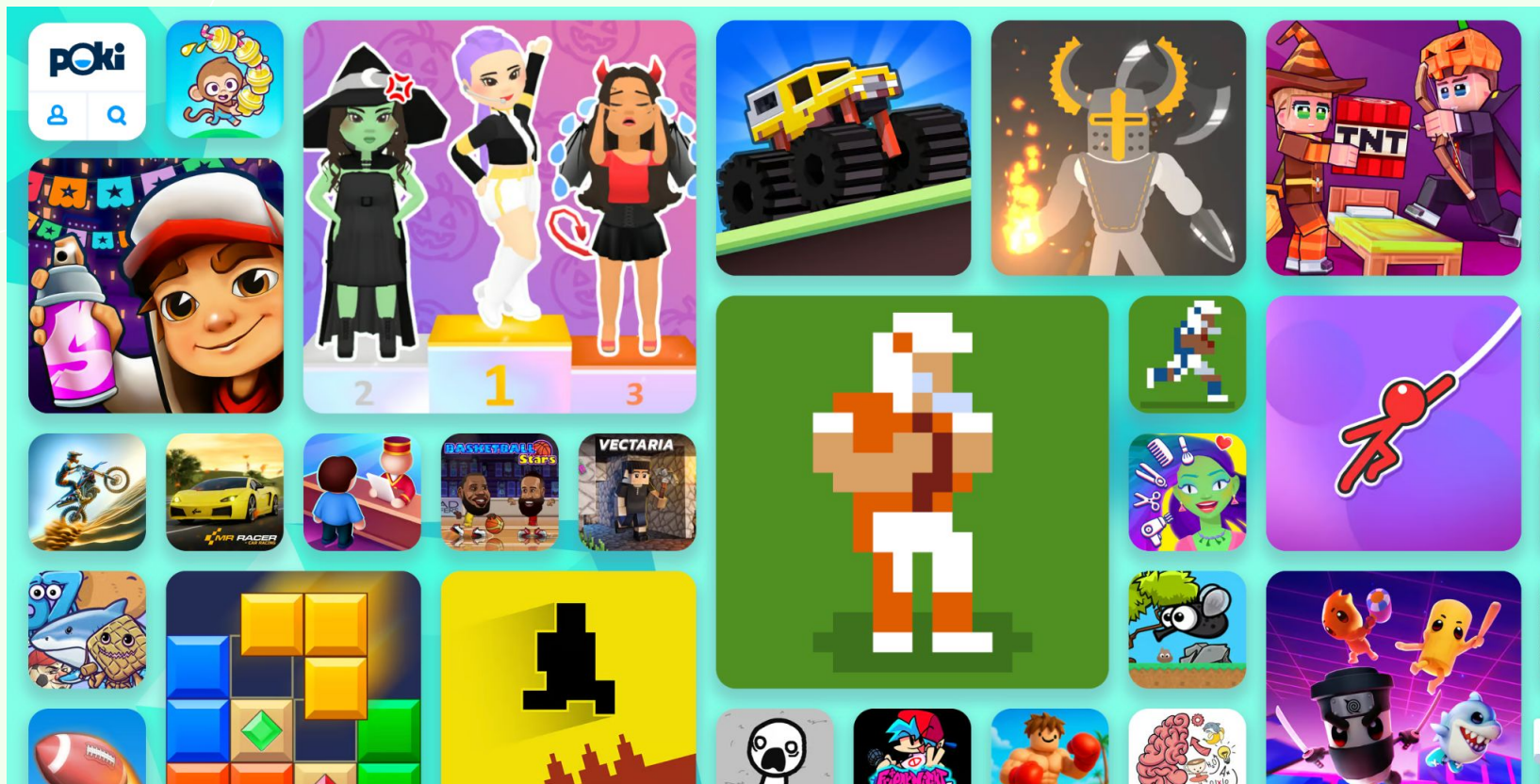
Their 24x7 media programmed by algorithms, shaped by influencers

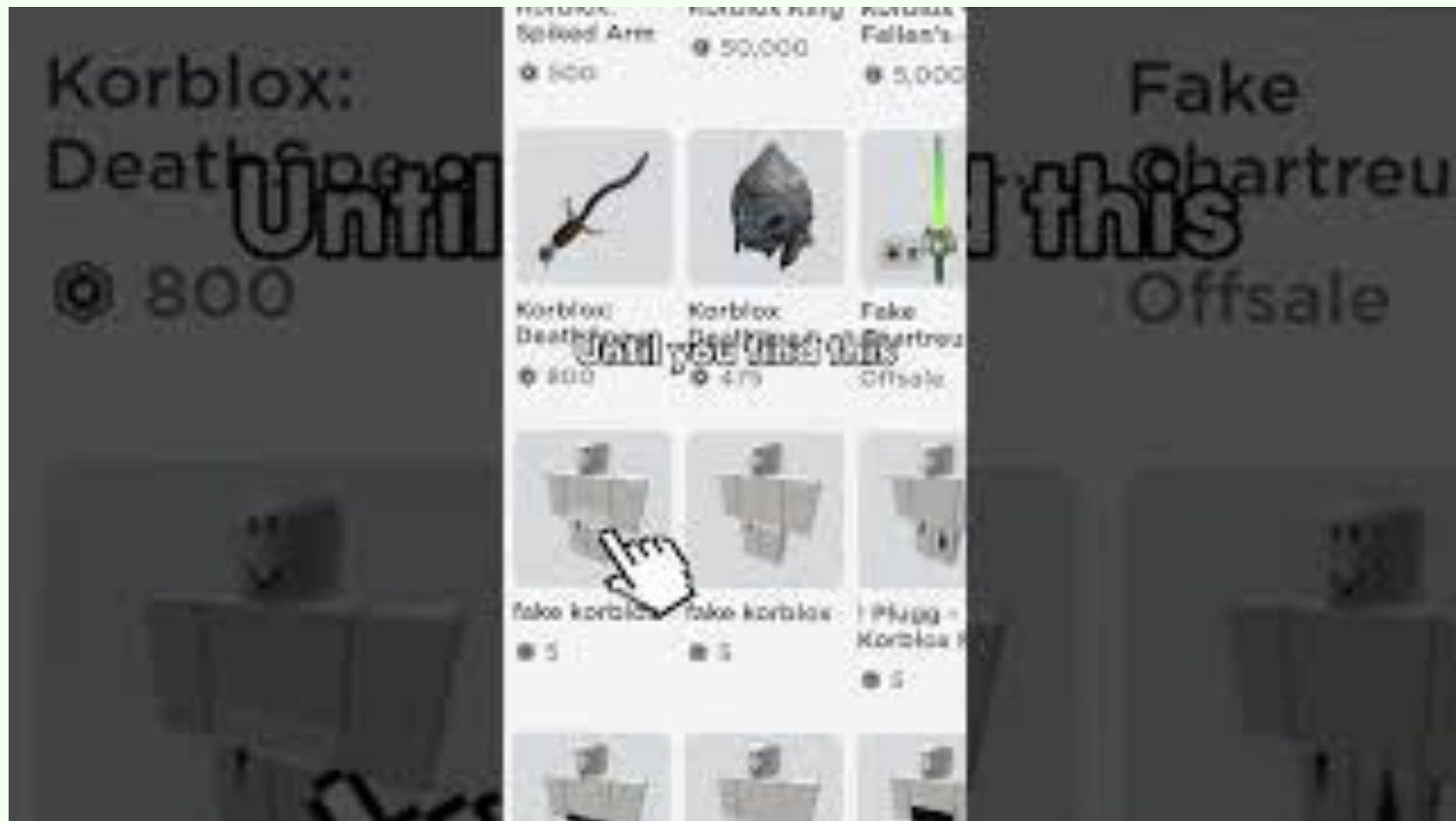

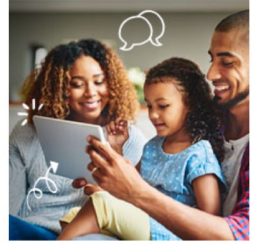

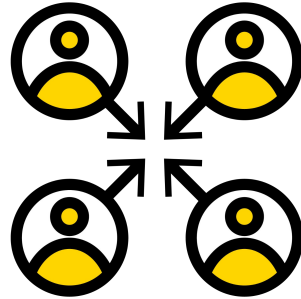
